

PET EMERGENCY KIT CHECKLIST

FOOD AND WATER

- Non-perishable food (at least 3 days' worth) in an airtight container
- Small supply of your pet's favorite treats
- Bottled water (at least 3 days' worth) for each animal
- Bowls for food and water (plastic or collapsable)
- Manual can opener
- Feeding instructions for each pet



MEDICAL SUPPLIES

- Copies of pet's medical records (vaccination history, emergency contact list).
- Full supply of medications (enough for at least 7 days)
- One month supply of flea, tick and heartworm preventative
- Pet first-aid kit (including antiseptic wipes, gauze, bandage rolls, etc.)
- Any additional supplements your pet needs.

COMFORT AND SANITATION

- Favorite blanket, toy, or other comfort item
- Leash, harness, collar with ID tag
- Appropriate-sized pet carrier, crate or travel bag that is sturdy for transporting your pet
- Bedding, blanket, or towel
- Waste disposal bags
- Cat litter (for cats), litter box and scoop
- Cleaning supplies - Paper towels, plastic bags, disinfectant wipes

PET EMERGENCY KIT CHECKLIST

IDENTIFICATION

- Current photos of each of your pets (with you if possible)
- Pet description—name, breed, sex, color and weight
- Microchip information (Microchip number, name and phone number of microchip company)
- Rabies Certificate
- Copies of registration information (ex. Proof of ownership or adoption records)
- Service animal documentation (if applicable)



ADDITIONAL ITEMS

- Muzzle (for dogs only): A properly fitted muzzle can be helpful in stressful situations, especially for anxious or aggressive dogs.
- Waterproof container for documents
