

French Bulldog Skin Care Guide

Daily

- Gently wipe facial folds with a medicated or vet-approved pet wipe (e.g., Malacetic).
- Check for redness, odor, or moisture buildup in skin folds, especially around the nose and tail.

Weekly

- Brush your Frenchie with a soft-bristle brush to remove loose hair and distribute skin oils.
- Check ears for signs of dirt, wax, or infection.

Monthly

- Bathe with a gentle, hypoallergenic or medicated shampoo.
- Trim nails and inspect paws for cracks or irritation

Signs of Skin Trouble

- Persistent scratching or licking
- Red or inflamed folds
- Hair loss or crusting
- Odor from folds or ears

Tips

- Always dry folds completely after cleaning or bathing.
- Use fragrance-free products designed for dogs with sensitive skin.
- If you notice signs of itching, redness, or odor, consult your vet.
